Glory, Transformation, Unity, Mission

John 17:20-23

What Jesus prayed for the 11 disciples in John 17:1–19, now Jesus prays for all believers. He prays these things happen so that God Unite Believers across time and geography so that the World may know the Gospel through seeing the Power of God Magnify Christ's Glory, Protect Christians' Faith from Satan, and Transform Christians by His Word. We will consider this text in the following way:

1. *People* Jesus Prays For: All Believers down through the Centuries (17:20).
2. *Points* of Jesus' Prayer (17:20; cf. 17:1–19):
 - a. God Magnify Christ (17:1–5).
 - b. God Protect Believers' Faith (17:11).
 - c. God Protect Believers From Satan (17:15).
 - d. God Transform Believers through the Word by the Spirit (17:17; cf. 16:13–15).
3. *Purposes* of Jesus' Prayer: Jesus' Prays that God Unite All Believers by and in Christ's Glory, His power in their lives, and transformation through the Word by the Spirit, so that the World Know the Gospel (17:21).
4. *Principals* Behind God's Uniting Believers so that the World Hears (17:22–23):
 - a. The Glory of Christ in the Church
 - b. The Glory of God the Father in Christ

Next week: As we finish Christ's prayer we see His amazing desire for us to share in His glory in eternity. Why would Jesus desire this? Read John 17:24-26 for next week.
