Tell the Next Generations Pt. 2

Psalm 78:9-64

In Psalm 78, God gives His people a vision to proclaim His Excellencies to the next generations so they set their hope in God! This week we see Asaph unpack and explain what this looks like by doing it for us in verses 9–64. We see him give snapshots of the:

The *Record* of Redemptive History in Asaph's Bible (Exodus–1 Samuel)

- God's People Turn Away (vv. 9–11)
- God's People Forgot the Exodus (vv. 12–39)
- God's People Forgot God in the Wilderness and Conquest in Joshua (vv. 40–55)
- God's People Tested God in the Promised Land as in Judges and 1 Samuel (vv. 56–64)

The *Rhythm* of Redemptive History

- God Works
- Man Sins
- God Works Again
- Man Sins Again...

The *Redemption* of Redemptive History

- The Greatness of God
- The Sinfulness of Man, even God's People
- The Faithfulness of God to Show Mercy & Compassion to His People
 - Shows Our Need for New Hearts
 - Shows Our Need for a Shepherd like God
 - Shows the Need for Continual Remembrance of God and Repentance in God's People through the Word's Record and Rhythm.

Next week: In our last week in Psalm 78, we'll land where the Psalm lands in verses 65–72, with David and the need of God's People for a Shepherd King! The call to tell the next generations about God's Excellencies is a call to be Christ-Centered in how we speak about the Word. It's all about Christ! See also, Luke 24:13–49
